# Summer Enrichment Program

June 20–July 24

Romona School (Grades K–3)

Wilmette Junior High School (Grades 4–7)

Take a leisurely walk with your child through the pages of this course brochure to plan an exciting summer of fun and learning. Build a schedule that meets your child's personal interests and your family's summer schedule. Students may enroll in one, two, or three classes daily. Shuttle bus service is available between each class period and as a link-up service with the village-wide Park District Programs.

**Please consider the following as you plan your Summer Enrichment Program (SEP) schedule of classes:**

- Don't forget to register early. Classes will be cancelled if we don't meet the required minimum enrollment.
- Each class is 50 minutes long
- Classes begin at 8:30 a.m. at Romona School (Grades K-3)
- Classes begin at 8:40 A.M. at Wilmette Junior High School (Grades 4-7)
- Students are eligible to enroll in District 39 SEP classes if they have **completed** any grade Kindergarten through 7th.
- Online registration opens February 5, 2018. Registration closes March 9, 2018.
- Late registrations will be accepted between March 19, 2018 and May 4, 2018. A \$9 late registration fee per class will be charged.
- Confirmation letters with class assignments and bus information will be sent approximately two weeks before classes start.
- If space is available after the session has begun, late registrations will be accepted on June 21, 2018 and June 22, 2018 at each school site. A \$9 late registration fee per class will be charged.
- **Tuition and fees are fully refundable for medical reasons or because of course cancellations.** In addition, a fifty percent refund of tuition and fees will be given for withdrawals before March 2, 2018. No refunds will be given after March 3, 2018. This practice is strictly enforced to allow completion of the Summer Enrichment Program hiring, and class supply purchasing. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

- Classes will not be held on Wednesday, July 4.
- Students should register for classes for the grade they will complete in June 2018.

## General Information

### Payment

Payment will be processed through RevTrak, the same company District 39 uses for payments throughout the school year. A \$5 fee will be assessed for a course change requested by a parent after registration has been processed.

### Emergency Information

The Emergency Information section on the form must be completed to register.

### Shuttle Bus Transportation

Bus service to Romona School and Wilmette Junior High School within District 39 boundaries will be provided to children for a \$140 fee, if sufficient requests are received. The schedule and routes will be announced prior to the opening of school. Please complete the transportation portion of your registration form to apply. **No additional stops will be added to the bus routes after the March 10, 2018 registration deadline.** Children registering after this date will be accommodated on existing routes.

### Avoca District 37 Transportation

Avoca School District will provide bus transportation to Romona School and Wilmette Junior High School for District 37 students. Bus transportation from a route within the District 37 boundaries to the Summer Enrichment Program sites before and after each period will be available for a \$140 transportation fee. **Please contact District 37 at 847-251-3138 to apply for transportation.**

### Park District Program Link-Ups

Bus service from Romona School and Wilmette Junior High School to Wilmette Park District camp locations will be available after third period classes. This service is included in the \$140 transportation fee and will be provided at the end of the SEP day (11:20 a.m. for Romona and 11:30 a.m. for Wilmette Junior High School).

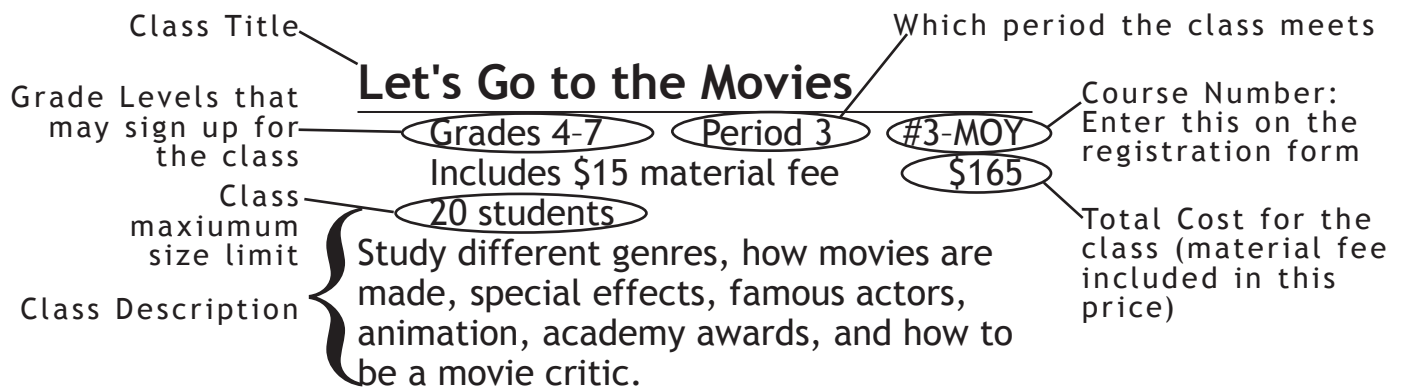

## Dates

## Location

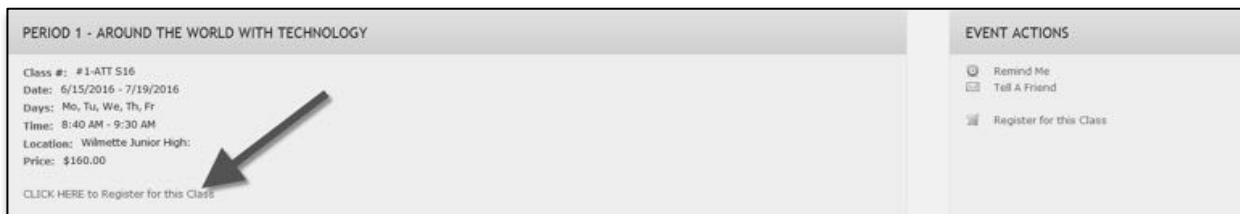
- Go to the Wilmette Public Schools Web Store at <https://wilmette.revtrak.net>

# Wilmette Park District Summer Camp 2018



## Registration

Register for the grade your child will enter in Fall 2018. A \$150 deposit per camp is required at the time of registration. Camp balances will be auto-debited from either your checking account or your credit card. You will

be asked at the time of registration to supply the appropriate information to process an auto-debit. The auto-debit process will be run on May 11, 2018, the summer camp payment deadline. Camp fees under \$150 must be paid in full at the time of registration. Wilmette Resident registration begins 9 a.m. Tuesday, February 6. Non-resident registration begins at 9 a.m. Tuesday, February 13. You may register online or via fax, mail, or walk-in. If you are registering via fax or mail you must include credit card information on your registration form along with a camp payment agreement. The registration fax number is 847-256-0739.

## Camp Refund Policy **New!**

We will refund 100% of the fee paid any time prior to 2 weeks before the start of the program. Under two weeks of a program's start date, we will refund your fee paid, less a 10% surcharge, up to a maximum of \$75. After the start of a program, a prorated refund for the remaining classes will be issued less a 10% surcharge with no maximum limit. This policy is strictly enforced to allow completion of camp preparations, ranging from staff hiring, camper groupings and supply purchasing to informational mailings. Your understanding is deeply appreciated.

## Early Bird Options

The Early Bird program begins at 8 a.m. and is available for most camps. In addition, an extra Early Bird is offered beginning at 7 a.m. for Sports Camp and Junior Day Camp. This program is for pre-camp use only. Check under each camp for the listing for times and fees.

## After Camp Programs

The Wilmette Park District offers an After Camp Recreation program that meets each day after camp ends. Pickup time is 6 p.m. The program meets at the Community Recreation Center, 3000

Glenview Road, Wilmette. Tiny Tots, Super Tots, Discovery and Wiggleworms Camps have separate After Camp programs. Bus transportation is provided for campers in Great Gillson, Sports, Junior Day, Afternoon Adventure, Wiggleworms and Camp F.U.S.I.O.N. Check camp descriptions for complete information.

## Camp Lunch Service

The Wilmette Park District partners with Kiddos Catering to provide lunch service to select camps. Food choices from several excellent restaurants in the Wilmette area. Lunches are delivered directly to your child's camp. A portion of the proceeds from this program will be donated to the Wilmette Park District Family Scholarship program. ## Transportation from District 39 Summer Enrichment Programs

Limited bus service is offered for children who will be attending Afternoon Adventure, Junior Day, Great Gillson, Sports, Arts in the Park or Broadway Bound camp after participating in District 39's Summer Enrichment program.

NOTE: Regardless of the time the students leave the Summer Enrichment programs they will only be bused by North Shore Transit (contracted by District 39) to their camps at 11:30 a.m. or after Third Period classes. If your camper attends the First or Second Period of Summer Enrichment you will be responsible for transporting your camper to camp.
