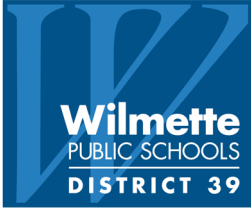

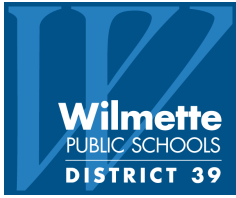
HVAC (Heating, Air Conditioning, Ventilation), Exhaust Systems.

After a careful review, Wilmette Public Schools District 39 has granted your request in part and denied it in part. The District has provided the names and contact information for those contractors or sub-contractors for whom contracts were let out to bid and awarded for the District's most recent project. The summer 2018 project at Highcrest Middle School includes a four classroom addition, office relocation and secure entry. We have also included the contact information for District 39's HVAC service agreements with ThermoFlo, Inc. and Schneider Electric.

Please be advised that we have withheld information regarding new construction, renovation and/or maintenance worked planned pursuant to Section 7(1)(h). 5 ILCS 140/ Freedom of Information Act, "Information prepared by or for the body in preparation of a bid solicitation shall be exempt until an award or final selection is made."

You have a right to have the District's response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

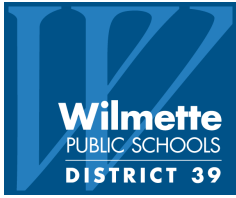


If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 days of the date of this letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC. You also have the right to seek judicial review of any denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.

As the District's FOIA Officer, I am responsible for the District's response to your requests, in consultation with the District's Superintendent. If I have misunderstood your requests in any way, please clarify your requests in writing to me.
