**Subject:**    **Fall Housing Report**

Attached are tables showing District 39 Fall Housing data and Fall Enrollment data. Fall Housing data is submitted annually to the State Board of Education based on the number of students attending District 39 schools as of September 30th of the current school year.

**Fall Housing**

As is suggested in the title, these numbers represent a “head count” of students housed in District 39 facilities. As such, it is important to note that this report:

- Only includes students attending in one of our six school buildings.
- Includes non-district students who attend District 39 programs (6 students).

As indicated in the District 39 Longitudinal Fall Housing Data by School chart, the number of students decreased for the past three years, totaling 3549 housed children. Without early childhood, there are 3485 students housed in District 39 schools.

**Enrollment**

Also, attached are charts describing district enrollment. To calculate district enrollment, the Fall Housing numbers are adjusted by subtracting non-district students attending district schools and by adding back District 39 children who receive special programs outside of district schools (students outplaced in therapeutic schools, students attending parochial schools needing special education services, and early childhood itinerant speech). All total, there are 3588 children who receive educational programming through District 39.
