The following is a list of supplies that every sixth grader will need. Quantities are indicated in parenthesis before the item name. Please note that some teachers may request minimal additional items through a separate list or letter.

- (1) Disk on Key/USB Drive/FlashDrive (128mb or more)
- (1) expandable file – with at least 7 slots
- loose leaf paper – approximately 200 sheets
- (3) one-subject spiral notebooks
- (1) three-subject (or more) notebook for Math
- (3) 1 inch, three-ring binders with pockets for Science, Social Studies, & Foreign Language
- (2) sets of 5 divider tabs for Science & Foreign Language binder
- (1) ½ inch, three-ring binder for Music
- (1) pocket folder for Drama
- (1) set of headphones with mini-jack for Technology labs
- (1) 12-inch ruler with both English and metric systems (non-bendable)
- (1) protractor
- (1) scissors
- (2) glue sticks
- (2) rolls scotch tape
- pencils – approximately 2 dozen
- (1) personal pencil sharpeners (for desk use)
- blue or black pens – approximately 1 dozen
- (2) red pens
- (1) pink eraser
- (1) set of washable markers
- (1) permanent marker
- (1) set of colored pencils
- (1) highlighter
- (1) package 3x5 lined index cards
- (3) family size boxes of facial tissue
- gym shoes for PE (to be kept at school)
